ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

Sealed proposals for the construction of miscellaneous water and sewer projects for the City of Auburndale (the Owner) will be received by the Owner, until 2:00 P.M. on July 24, 2008, local time at Public Utilities Department, Utilities Building, 215 Main Street, Auburndale, Florida. Bids received after said time will be returned unopened. Projects for which bids are to be received include:

1. Howard Road Lift Station Abandonment
2. Elaine Drive Water Main
3. Lake Myrtle Park Water Main
4. Tenoroc Reclaimed Water Main Extension

Bidders submitting proposals for any project must submit proposals on all work of that project to receive consideration.

Character and amount of security to be furnished by each bidder are stated in the bid documents.

The principal features of the Contracts include:

1. Howard Road Lift Station Abandonment: Construction of approximately 450 linear feet of 8" gravity sewer main; 210 foot pilot-tube microtunnel, manholes, and modifications to existing structures, together with miscellaneous earthwork, fittings, pipe construction and restoration.
2. Elaine Drive Water Main: Construction of approximately 1650 linear feet of 12" water main, including directional bores, connection to existing water mains, valves, hydrants and fittings, together with miscellaneous earthwork, pipe work, testing, disinfection, analysis, and restoration.
3. Lake Myrtle Park Water Main: Construction of approximately 7900 linear feet of 12" water main, including directional bores, connection to existing water

mains, valves, hydrants and fittings, together with miscellaneous earthwork, pipe work, testing, disinfection, analysis, and restoration.

4. Tenoroc Reclaimed Water Main Extension: Construction of approximately 3400 linear feet of 12" effluent reuse main, including directional bores, connection to existing irrigation mains, valves, and fittings, together with miscellaneous earthwork, pipe work, testing, disinfection, analysis, and restoration.

The Public Construction bond, and specified insurance are required to be secured from or countersigned by an agency of the surety or insurance company, which agency shall have an established place of business in Florida and be duly licensed to conduct business therein.

Bids shall be enclosed within a sealed envelope with the words "BID ENCLOSED", Project Name, and the Bidder's name clearly marked on the outside thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to waive informalities in any bid; to reject any or all bids in whole or in part, with or without cause; and/or to accept the bid that in his judgment will be in his best interest.
